The Cades Cove Loop trail is the most popular scenic drive in all of the Great Smoky Mountains, so you don't want to miss it!

Details:

We will meet up at 9:30 on the morning of Aug 28th (Sunday) at the Townsend visitors center (7906 East Lamar Alexander Parkway Townsend Tn 37882). We will line up in the field beside the visitor's center and be ready to leave by 11:00am. We will head into the Great Smoky Mountains National Park and follow the Cades Cove Loop Trail along it's 11 miles and return to Townsend. Cades Cove Loop is a one-way road.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION, PLEASE READ: During the convoy stay a safe distance from the vehicle in front of you, but keep it tight, please avoid large gaps. If you want to stop to take pictures please pull off the road, don't stop the flow of traffic. Bring a lunch or snacks. Take a Restroom break at Townsend Visitors Center before we leave. There are restrooms in the park at the campground and at the Grist mill (the half way point through the loop.) This is an all pavement ride. ~ DONATIONS to the Great Smoky Mountains National Park are greatly appreciated and a donation box is located in Cades Cove.
